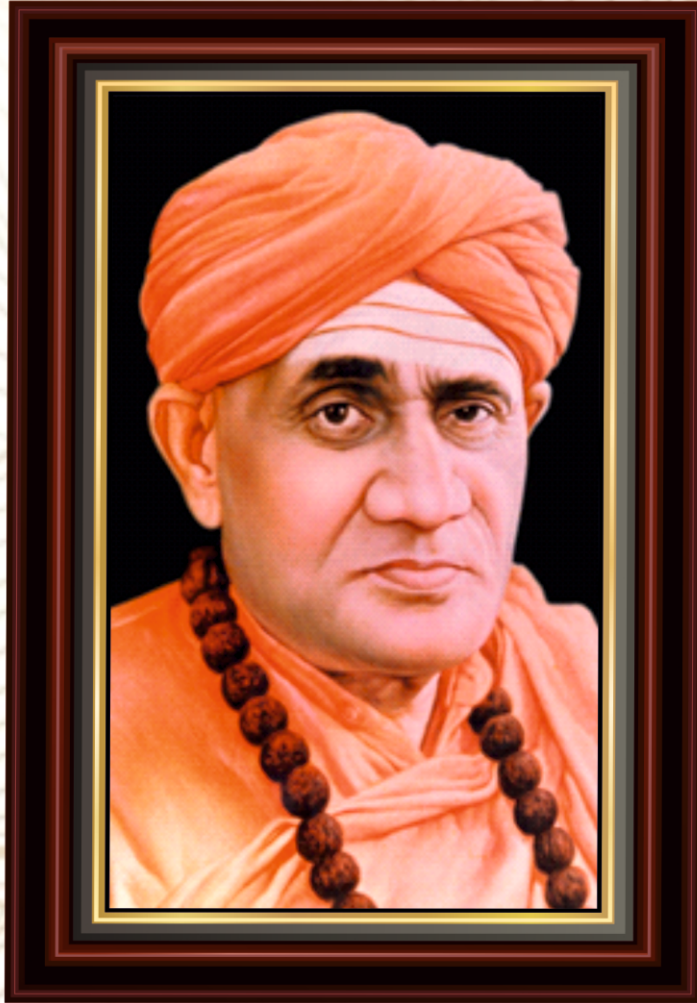

New Education Policy : (Semester System) :

Consequent to globalization and new innovations in the educational standards the New Education Policy is adopted through semester system is introduced to equip the students to face challenges with multidimensional approach in the competitive world. The Davangere University has introduced this system in all the affiliated colleges. As such our college has adhered to this system. Instead of annual examinations at the end of the every year, one semester examinations after every four months is conducted besides conducting tests, seminars etc., internal assessments and qualitative teaching is imparted. Our college has two units of National Service Scheme (NSS) to equip women students to shoulder social responsibilities. Each unit has enrolled 100 students and are taught the importance of Environmental Awareness, Blood Donation, Literacy Campaign, Conservation of Archaeological monuments and Awareness on AIDS etc., besides educating common people on social problems etc., in 7 days camps arranged in rural areas in order to make the participants to be aware of the rural life condition,
